



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

UNIVERSITI MALAYSIA TERENGGANU

AND

UNIVERSITAS MALIKUSSALEH

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (hereinafter referred to as the "MoU") is dated this day of 12th December 2018

BETWEEN

UNIVERSITI MALAYSIA TERENGGANU (hereinafter referred to as "UMT"), an institution of higher learning established under the Universities and University Colleges Act 1971 whose address is at 21030, Kuala Terengganu and shall include its lawful representatives and permitted assigns; of the one part,

AND

UNIVERSITAS MALIKUSSALEH (hereinafter referred to as "UNIMAL"), an institution of higher learning Indonesia whose address is at **Kampus Utama Cot Tengku Nie Reuleut, Muara Batu, Aceh Utara 24351, Provinsi Aceh, INDONESIA** and shall include its lawful representatives and permitted assigns; of the other part.

UMT and UNIMAL shall hereinafter refer to singularly as "the Party" and collectively as "the Parties".

WHEREAS:

- A. UMT is an established university which strives to enhance and strengthen its academic and research activities and has taken various initiatives to compliment its educational excellence. UMT has entered into various collaborative arrangements with other parties to enhance its research capabilities.
- B. UNIMAL is a second biggest public universities in Aceh, Indonesia with international standard in developing agro-technology, agribusiness, information systems, marine engineering, economics, social and political, and art to enhance the quality of life and culture.

- C. The Parties hereby agree to enter into this MoU to declare their respective intentions and to establish a basis of co-operation and collaboration between the Parties upon the terms as contained herein.

THE PARTIES HAVE REACHED AN UNDERSTANDING as follows:

ARTICLE I
OBJECTIVE

The Parties, subject to the terms of this MoU and the laws, rules, regulations and national policies from time to time in force in each Party's country, will endeavour to strengthen, promote and develop research co-operation between the Parties on the basis of equality and mutual benefit.

ARTICLE II
AREAS OF CO-OPERATION

1. Each Party will, subject to the laws, rules, regulations and national policies from time to time in force, governing the subject matter in their respective countries, endeavour to take necessary steps to encourage and promote co-operation in the following areas –
 - (a) collaboration in curriculum and conducting programme of study;
 - (b) collaboration in research projects and publications;
 - (c) conducting in conferences and academic meetings;
 - (d) student exchange and practicum and internship programme;
 - (e) exchange of faculty members;
 - (f) the conduct of special projects for mutual benefit; and
 - (g) any other areas of co-operation to be mutually agreed upon by the Parties.
2. For the purpose of implementing the co-operation in respect of any areas stated in paragraph 1 the Parties will enter into a legally binding agreement subject to terms and conditions as mutually agreed upon by the Parties.

ARTICLE III
FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

1. This MoU will not give rise to any financial obligation by one Party to other.
2. Each Party will bear its own cost and expenses in relation to this MoU.

ARTICLE IV
CONFIDENTIALITY

1. Each Party shall undertake to observe the confidentiality and secrecy of documents, information and other data received from or supplied to, the other party during the period of the implementation of this MoU or any other agreements made pursuant to this MoU.
2. For purposes of paragraph 1 above, such documents, information and data include any document, information and data which is disclosed by a party (the Disclosing party) to the other party (the Receiving party) prior to, or after, the execution of this MoU, involving technical, business, marketing, policy, know-how, planning, project management and other documents, information, data and /or solutions in any form, including but not limited to any document, information or data which is designated in writing to be confidential or by its nature intended to be for the knowledge of the Receiving party or if orally given, is given in the circumstances of confidence.
3. Both Parties agree that the provisions of this Article shall continue to be binding between the Parties notwithstanding the early termination or expiration of this MoU.

ARTICLE V
EFFECT OF MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Notwithstanding any obligations of the Parties contained herein, this MoU serves only as a record of the Parties' intentions and does not constitute or create, and is not intended to constitute or create, obligations under domestic or international law and will not give rise to any legal process and will not be deemed to constitute or create any legally binding or enforceable obligations, express or implied.

ARTICLE VI
ENTRY INTO EFFECT AND DURATION

1. This MoU will come into effect on the date of signing and will remain in effect for a period of five (5) years
2. This MoU may be extended for a further period of five (5) years subject to mutual agreement in writing by the Parties.

ARTICLE VII
NOTICES

Any communication under this MoU will be in writing in the Bahasa Malaysia or English language and delivered by registered mail to the address or sent to the electronic mail address or facsimile number of UMT or UNIMAL, as the case may be, shown below or to such other address or electronic mail address or facsimile number as either Party may have notified the sender and shall, unless otherwise provided herein, be deemed to be duly given or made when delivered to the recipient at such address or electronic mail address or facsimile number which is duly acknowledged:

ARTICLE VIII

VARIATION

The terms stipulated in this MoU shall not be amended, altered, changed or otherwise modified without the mutual consent of the Parties and such amendments, alterations, changes and modifications shall be made in writing and signed by the Parties hereto.

ARTICLE IX

DISPUTE RESOLUTION

Any difference or dispute between the Parties concerning the interpretation and/or implementation and/or application of any of the provisions of this MoU shall be settled amicably through mutual consultation and/or negotiations between the Parties, without reference to any third party.

ARTICLE X

NO AGENCY

Nothing contained herein is to be construed so as to constitute a joint venture partnership or formal business organisation of any kind between the Parties or so to constitute either Party as the agent of the other.

ARTICLE XI

ASSIGNMENT

Unless otherwise agreed in writing, both Parties shall not transfer or assign all or any of their rights, obligations, interests or benefits hereunder to any third party.

ARTICLE XII

SUSPENSION

Each Party reserves the right for reasons of national security, national interest, public order or public health to suspend temporarily, either in whole or in part, the implementation of this MoU which suspension shall take effect immediately after notification has been given to the other Party.

LETTER OF INTENT

BETWEEN

**SCHOOL OF SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT,
UNIVERSITI MALAYSIA TERENGGANU, MALAYSIA**

AND

**FACULTY OF POLITICAL AND SOCIAL SCIENCES
UNIVERSITAS MALIKUSSALEH, INDONESIA**

1. In line with the development of friendly international cooperation and in accordance with our mutual interests in developing programs of academic and scholarly exchanges and for the purpose of establishing a long-term mutually beneficial association, the **School of Social and Economic Development ("SSED"), Universiti Malaysia Terengganu ("UMT"), 21030 Kuala Nerus, Terengganu, MALAYSIA** and **Faculty of Political and Social Sciences, Universitas Malikussaleh, Kampus Bukit Indah, Lhokseumawe, Aceh, INDONESIA**, execute this Letter of Intent. Both parties agree to exercise their best efforts to develop the following forms of cooperation:
 - (a) collaboration in curriculum and conducting programme of study;
 - (b) collaboration in research projects and publications;
 - (c) conducting in conferences and academic meetings;
 - (d) student exchange and practicum and internship programme;
 - (e) exchange of faculty members;
 - (f) the conduct of special projects for mutual benefit; and
 - (g) any other areas of co-operation to be mutually agreed upon by the parties.
2. Any activities under this Letter of Intent can only be carried out when it does not go against the institutions and/or the countries' rules and regulations.
3. Each party will appoint its' own representatives to coordinate and undertake the implementation of the proposed cooperation under this Letter of Intent. ("Coordinators").

4. Both parties may give proposals on any activities to be carried out under the Letter of Intent as provided herein. Such proposals will be reviewed and deliberated in joint meetings chaired by any one of the Coordinators.
5. Approval of any activities will be subject to availability of funds and benefits to be attained by both parties.
6. Progress of activities will be reviewed and monitored by the Coordinators.
7. The validity of this Letter of Intent shall be for a period of two (2) years effective from the date of signing.

The signing of this Letter of Intent declares only the arrangement of the parties to cooperate and is not a binding international agreement.
